1	Doctor of Medicine (MD)	Direct Entry: Three principal passes in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology, at Advanced (“A”) level with a minimum entry point of 6 points. Whereby one must have at least a D grade in Chemistry, Biology, and Physics. Equivalent Entry. Holders of a Bachelor’s degree in Biomedical Sciences from a recognized institution with a GPA of 3.0 or above.
