CALL FOR SECOND ROUND APPLICATIONS (DIPLOMA) ACADEMIC YEAR 2026/2027

Muhimbili University of Health and Allied Sciences (MUHAS) invite applications for admission to Diploma Programs for the Academic Year 2026/2027.

- Applicants who were **NOT selected** and think they meet the minimum entry requirements may Re apply by clicking the **Reapplication Button**.
- **New** applicants are required to follow application procedures and follow instructions given in each step including payment of non-refundable application fee
- All applicants holding foreign qualifications **Must** have their qualifications validated and equated by the respective regulatory bodies before submitting their applications for admissions as follows:
 - The National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA) in respect of certificates of Secondary Education and Teacher Education; and
 - The National Council for Technical and Vocational Education and Training (NACTVET) in respect of NTA level 6 qualification
- Application fee is 10,000/= for **Local & new applicants** and 10 USD for foreign applicants
- Applicants must ascertain themselves that they possess the minimum entry qualifications plus the number of available slots before starting application. Applicants will be selected to join the University based on their qualifications and fulfilment of entry requirements and **NOT** otherwise.
- Deadline for Application and re-application is strictly on 21st September, 2026.
